We are looking for students to assist the Union Voice Team in the Union Election process throughout the voting periods by talking to students about the Union Elections, encouraging them to vote, and supporting students in using the voting software

There are several Election voting periods throughout the academic year which successful candidates can get involved with. This role initially covers the Snap Election's voting period (Monday 14th – Wednesday 16th October)

Most shifts are concentrated around the busy lunchtime periods and are negotiable to fit around teaching and study commitments

The role of an Election Assistant (Vote Herder) is varied and fun, with plenty of student contact.

So, if you are a quick learner, able to remain impartial, and would enjoy talking to students about the Union, the Election process, and encouraging them to vote, then we want to hear from you. Training will be provided.

Reporting to: Democracy & Governance Coordinator

Purpose of Role

To talk to students about the Union Elections and encourage them to vote, as well as receive any feedback about the elections process.

Key Tasks

- Approaching students on campuses across the University of Derby to encourage students to vote in the Union Elections.
- Remain impartial at all times to the various candidates running in the elections
- Gain an in-depth knowledge of the elections process to confidently reply to questions about the elections process.
- Receive any feedback from University of Derby students about the elections process.
- Assist with social media promotion by being a positive Union ambassador on social media channels.
- To observe all union policies, governing documents, financial regulations and legal requirements.
- To undertake any additional duties required for the role.

General Notes

The principal roles and responsibilities may change from shift to shift, and the post holder may be required to undertake any additional duties as deemed appropriate.

Staff must carry out their duties with full regard to the rules policies and procedures and conditions of service contained in the staff information guide

Please note it is imperative that post holders remain impartial in the election process whilst they are on shift or talking to any students they have met through the role.
